Rules for practical lessons

- Students should be warmed-up, prepared and on time for their practical lesson at the agreed time.
- 2. Sufficient practice and preparation is a prerequisite to receive a practical lesson. The lecturer will not use the lesson time to practise repertoire with the student. Also, the lecturer's responsibility is to help students master their craft as an instrumentalist/vocalist, not to teach the rudiments of music theory and notation.
- Should a student cancel a practical lesson, with or without an excuse, the lecturer will
 not be under any obligation to reschedule the lesson. If the student had a valid reason
 for cancelling a lesson, it is up to the lecturer to decide if his/her time allows for
 rescheduling.
- 4. Should a lecturer cancel a practical lesson due to official meetings or unforeseen circumstances, the lesson will be rescheduled.
- 5. In addition to other requirements, students have to attend at least 18 practical lessons before the start of the year-end exams to gain entry for the practical exam.
- 6. If a student has attended less than 6 practical lessons by the end of the first semester, the module will be cancelled.

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
