

## **Rules for practical lessons**

1. Students should be warmed-up, prepared and on time for their practical lesson at the agreed time.
2. Sufficient practice and preparation is a prerequisite to receive a practical lesson. The lecturer will not use the lesson time to practise repertoire with the student. Also, the lecturer's responsibility is to help students master their craft as an instrumentalist/vocalist, not to teach the rudiments of music theory and notation.
3. Should a student cancel a practical lesson, with or without an excuse, the lecturer will not be under any obligation to reschedule the lesson. If the student had a valid reason for cancelling a lesson, it is up to the lecturer to decide if his/her time allows for rescheduling.
4. Should a lecturer cancel a practical lesson due to official meetings or unforeseen circumstances, the lesson will be rescheduled.
5. In addition to other requirements, students have to attend at least 18 practical lessons before the start of the year-end exams to gain entry for the practical exam.
6. If a student has attended less than 6 practical lessons by the end of the first semester, the module will be cancelled.

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
