REMEMBER: The content of the research proposal, ethics application, informed consent statement and recruitment material must be **aligned**.



Research proposal

- (1) Title of my study
- (2) Keywords
- (3) Introduction and background
- (4) Research questions
- (5) Research objectives
- (6) Hypotheses or central theory
- (7) Methodology
(design, population, sampling, recruitment process, inclusion & exclusion criteria, remuneration, data collection, data analysis, researcher qualifications & ethics training)
- (8) Data storage
- (9) Research monitoring
- (10) Informed consent
- (11) Confidentiality, anonymity, privacy and respect
- (12) Dissemination & publication
- (13) List of references
- (14) Risk level

Length: 10-15 pages **at most**.
Refer to the **prescribed templates of your Research Focus Area or Unit**.



Ethics application

- (1) Title of my study
- (2) Keywords
- (3) Background and motivation
- (4) Research objectives
- (5) Hypotheses or central theory
- (6) Methodology
(design, population, sampling, inclusion & exclusion criteria, recruitment process, remuneration, data collection, data analysis, researcher qualifications & ethics training)
- (7) Data storage

- (14) Attach all the required documentation

Informed consent statement

- (1) Nature of study?
- (2) Justification for including participants?
- (3) Responsibilities of the participants?
- (4) Responsibilities of the researcher?
- (5) Benefits for participants?
- (6) Risks AND strategies to address this?
- (7) Who will access the data?
- (8) What will the data be used for?
- (9) Remuneration and costs?
- (10) How will you share the findings?
- (11) Who can participants contact for more info?

Refer to the **compulsory template**.



Recruitment material

- (1) Title of the study?
- (2) What is the focus of/reason for the study?
- (3) Who should participate in the study?
- (4) Why should they participate?
- (5) What are the responsibilities of the participants?
- (6) What are the responsibilities of the researcher?
- (7) How will you protect the wellbeing of the participants?
- (8) Where can the participants reach you?
- (9) Attach proof of gatekeeper agreements and recruitment materials (e.g. advertisements, flyers, etc.)

Very important:
Use **plain language**
(avoid academic jargon)
